



The Co-Chair's report 2021

Welcome to the Annual General Meeting of the Friends of Wymondham College Prep School (FOWCPS or 'Friends').

Before the term had ended we had organised a raffle and summer picnic for our Covid-interrupted first year of reception children. Since then we have had 5 additional meetings attended by around 11 members each meeting. Minutes are expertly taken by our Secretary, Kelly, to whom we are eternally grateful for her organisational skills and speed! Since then our Events team have worked tirelessly to come up with ideas for events both to raise funds and to ensure the children and parents feel welcomed as part of the school community. It has been a difficult start to the school year with Covid still dampening our plans, but this has just meant we have all had to be a little more creative in our ideas, and you have all done a fantastic job! Being a brand-new group, has also meant we lacked the initial funds to put on many events, but as we grow both financially and with additional members, we hope to be able to offer a wider variety of events going forwards.

Our main fundraising aim at the moment is for the Forest School/Outside classroom. However, in the Autumn term of 2021 we were able to use some of the funds we had already accrued to put towards some outdoor toys for the playgrounds and an outdoor library. This showed our commitment to providing equipment to support the school and pupils.
